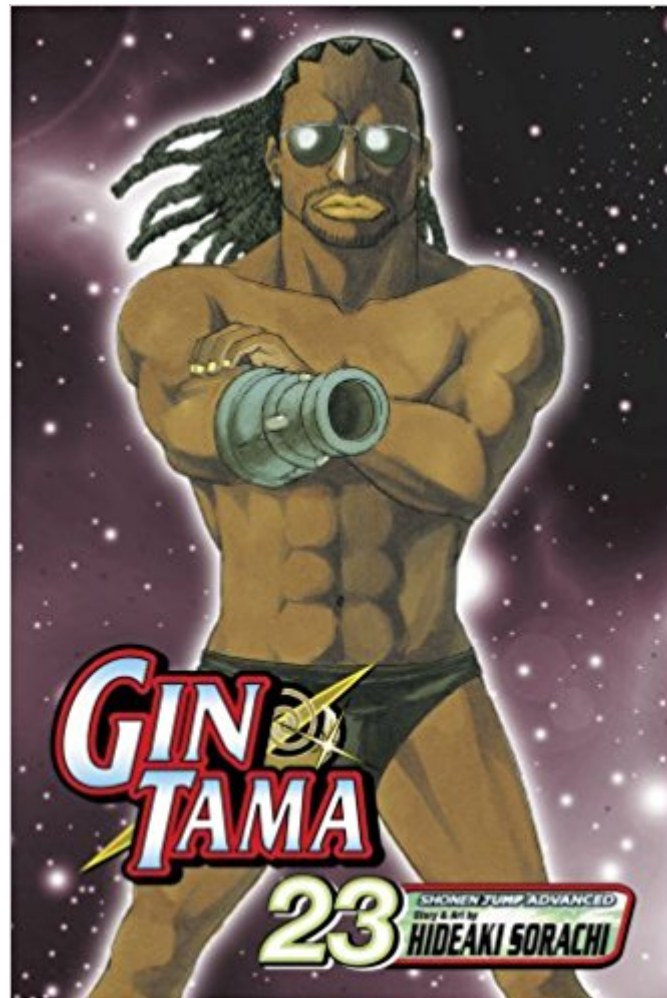


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Gin Tama, Vol. 23

Sad that Viz wants to spend time on series that don't matter.
