

I am afraid that his natural intelligence will fail him because he is not ambitious about his studies. He does well in school; however, his parents and I are very concerned about the sincerity and seriousness of his teachers.

I bought one of Basher's book at a book fair at my kiddies' school and have been buying since. My kids LOVE these books! The explanation is easy to understand and Basher makes it fun for my kids. My son especially loves looking at the pictures. They are 9 and 11 and when the new book

came, they almost fought for it. They take the books to school and share with the class and their classmates love them too. I am donating the set to the school library.

I bought this book for myself (I am 26) as I wanted to improve my grammar but wanted a precise explanation and not long winded pages worth in adult books. This book is very easy to understand and gives you examples, pictures, and very clear and easy to understand definitions. I would recomment this for kids but also adults wishing to improve their grammar.

Who knew punctuation could be so much fun? My daughter LOVES Simon Basher's books, and immediately began gleefully looking for and identifying punctuation marks whenever they occurred, explaining in detail just what they did. From Hyphen to Colon to the lowly period, she considers them good friends. I'd love to see Simon Basher attack grammar next!
