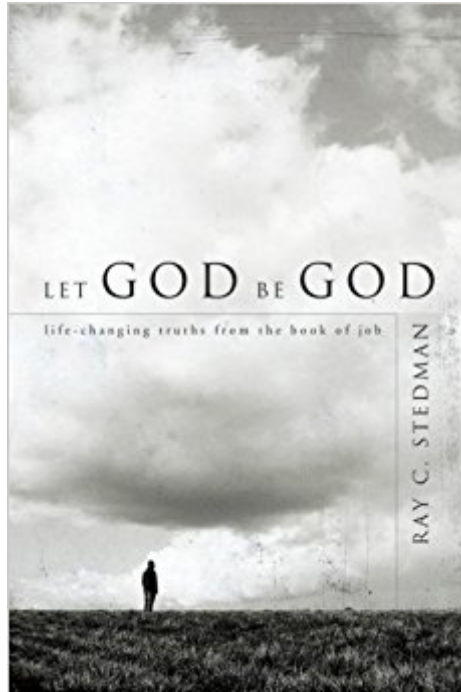


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Let God Be God: Life-Changing Truths From The Book Of Job
