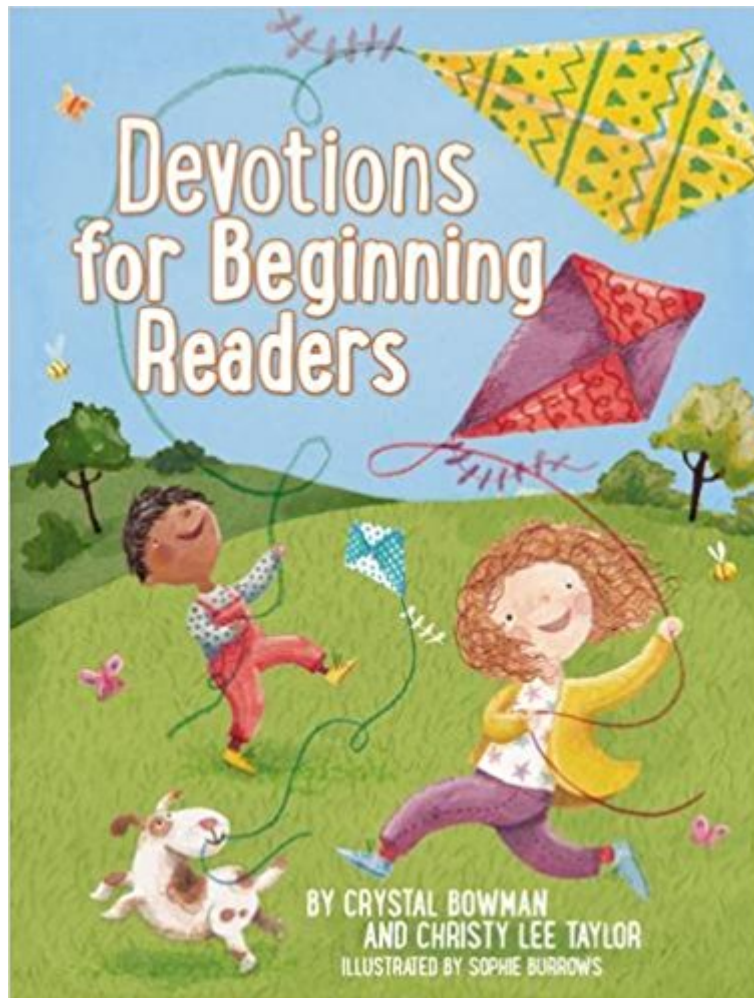

devotion ties into the scripture at the bottom of the page. We've been very pleased with this devotion book.
