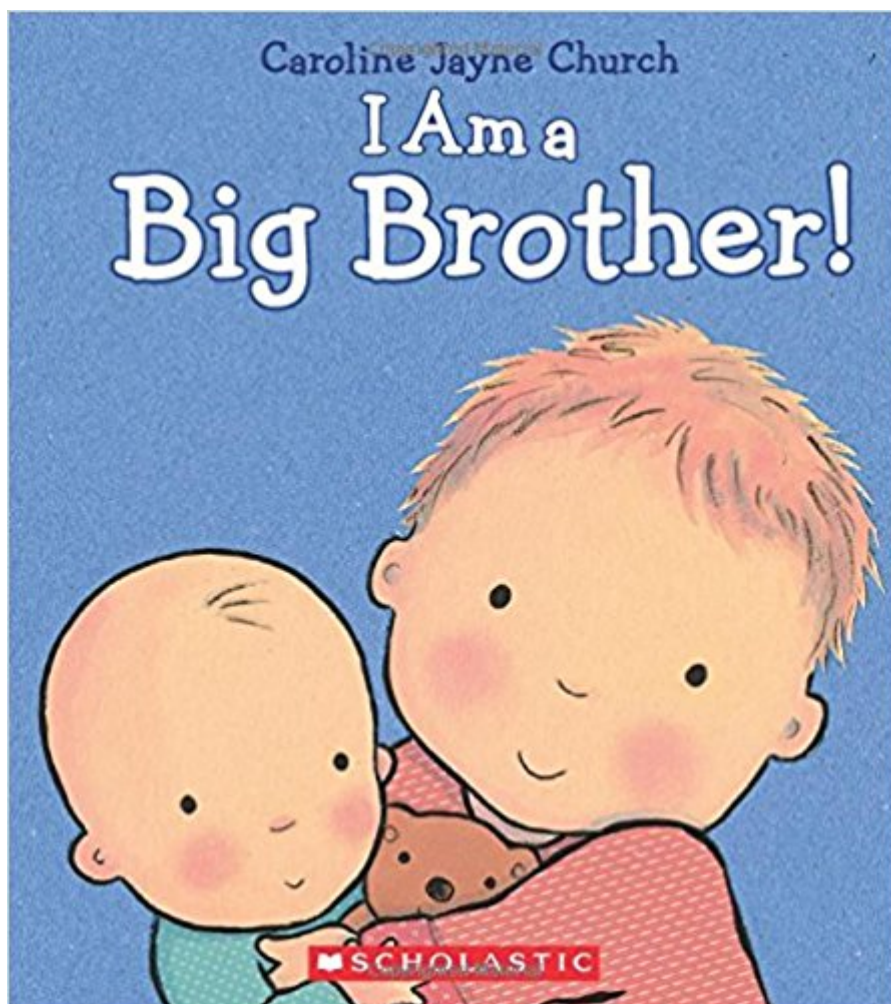

My son LOVES this book. I am thrilled that it teaches him some of the things that he can do to help when the baby arrives. He is 19 months just to give you an age range. I also like how the book points out that he is an important part of the family even though there is a new baby. This would be a great gift for anyone expecting their second child!

Cute book. I read it to my 2 year old every night because he will have a little brother coming home soon. The illustrations are cute and the content is the right amount. My son asks for it now. The book also includes some very real experiences (like having big brother help change the baby's diaper by getting a clean diaper for mom and dad) and we use the rhyme in the book to help remind him of that, which gets him involved. This was a great purchase to help ease the transition of a new baby in our house.
